



Launching of the private-public sector consultation

Date: January 2024

UN Global Compact Network Egypt, in partnership with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), proudly hosted the first public-private consultation on Egypt's National Anti-Corruption Strategy 2023-2030.

The session brought together representatives from the private sector and the Administrative Control Authority (ACA) to foster meaningful dialogue on advancing transparency and accountability. Joined by a collective of our participant companies, the consultation delved into the framework and objectives of the national anti-corruption strategy, addressing investment challenges and opportunities while exploring mechanisms to strengthen anti-corruption efforts. This consultation, focusing on SDG 16 (Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions), discussed how to streamline anti-corruption frameworks and create a more transparent and sustainable business environment.

Through this collaboration, participants discussed pathways to strengthen integrity in business practices, furthering efforts toward a more accountable society. This pivotal event reflects our ongoing commitment to bridging the gap between public and private stakeholders, promoting sustainable development, and reinforcing integrity in Egypt's business practices.







Business and Human Rights Accelerator

Date: February 2024

In February 2024, UN Global Compact Network Egypt officially launched the Business and Human Rights Accelerator, an initiative aimed at helping companies navigate and advance human rights practices within their organizations. The launch event brought together participating companies, including Etisalat, Enroot, GVOS, Juhayna, Orascom, Tatweer Misr, and Hassan Allam, all of whom are committed to embedding human rights principles into their business operations. The accelerator provides companies with the tools, resources, and expertise needed to assess their impact on human rights, take meaningful actions, and align their operations with international standards.

Looking ahead to 2025, the program will expand its impact through strategic recruitment, bringing on new participants to further strengthen the business community's commitment to human rights. As more companies join, the accelerator will continue to be a vital platform for fostering corporate responsibility and supporting the evolution of Egypt's business landscape towards greater transparency and ethical practices.

Sustain 360, LCA Advanced Training

Date: April 2024

In April 2024, UNGC Network Egypt successfully hosted the first round of the Sustain-360 capacity-building program for the year. This comprehensive four-day training session welcomed 15 trainees from our participant companies, focusing on Life Cycle Assessment (LCA).

Under the expert guidance of Dr. Nasser Ayoub, PhD, CEO and Cofounder of EPD Egypt, participants gained valuable insights into evaluating a product's environmental impact throughout its entire lifecycle. The training empowered businesses to optimize their resource use, reduce environmental liabilities, and strengthen their sustainability practices. This initiative highlights our commitment to equipping companies with the necessary tools to make more informed and responsible environmental decisions.



UNGC Network Egypt Annual Forum

Date: May 2024

On May 20, 2024, the UN Global Compact Network Egypt launched its flagship Annual Forum, "Pathways to Sustainable Africa," at the Nile Ritz-Carlton Hotel in Cairo. The event united leaders from the private sector, government, and civil society to address key challenges and opportunities for achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) across Africa.

In collaboration with the UNGC Africa Hub, ABLC Coalition, Resident Coordinator Office in Egypt, AmCham Egypt, and the EU Commission, the forum served as a call to action for mobilizing the private sector toward a sustainable future. The program opened with keynote speeches from Dr. Rania Al-Mashat, Dr. Mahmoud Mohieldin, Ambassador Christian Berger, and Elena Panova, alongside impactful opening remarks by UNGCNE Chairman Ayman Ismail.





Dynamic roundtable discussions delved into pivotal topics shaping Africa's development:

- Financing the Future: Chaired by Mr. Ayman Ismail, with insights from speakers like Dr. Rania Al-Mashat and Dr. Ahmed Kouchouk, this session focused on innovative financial mechanisms to drive sustainable growth.
- Food Security & Climate Resilience: Co-hosted by UNDP and moderated by Tolulope Lewis-Tamoka, this session featured experts such as Dr. Mohamed Abdel Aty and Ms. Christine Arab, highlighting strategies to build resilient food systems.
- Green Hydrogen & Renewable Energy: Moderated by Ms.
 Ghada Hammouda, panelists like Dr. Karim Morsy and Yasmine
 Khamis explored the role of renewable energy and green
 hydrogen in achieving a clean energy transition.
- Building Responsible Supply Chains: Led by Eng. Abir Leheta, this discussion tackled ethical sourcing practices with insights from speakers like Rear Admiral Reda Ahmed Ismail and Khaled El Sakty.
- Sustainable Communities for Africa: Moderated by Mr. Ayman Ismail, this session addressed urban development and technology transfer, featuring speakers like Dr. Khaled El-Enany and Omar El Hamamsy.

The forum emphasized collaborative approaches to advance sustainable development across Africa. It provided actionable strategies for fostering partnerships and leveraging innovation to build a sustainable future, aligned with the "Rescue Plan for People and Planet" proposed by UN Secretary–General António Guterres.

The event was made possible with the support of sponsors and partners, including Tatweer Misr, Juhayna Food Industries, AmCham Egypt, EGYTRANS, Food Lover, ACUD, Banque Misr, Al Masry Al Youm, and Climate CC Plus.

The forum was live-streamed globally, amplifying its impact and demonstrating a shared commitment to Africa's sustainable development.



Sustain 360 Round two beginners level

Date: July 2024

The second round of Sustain 360's beginners-level training took place in July 2024, offering participants a comprehensive understanding of sustainability in business. This program delved deeper than the basics, empowering participants with the knowledge and tools to integrate sustainable practices into their organizations.

Topics covered included the UN Global Compact's 10 principles, the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), carbon footprint management, the Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM), circular economies, anti-corruption efforts, digitalization in sustainability, and sustainability in the Arab world. Participants gained practical skills and insights to contribute to achieving both global sustainability targets and organizational goals. Through expert-led discussions and case studies, the training set the foundation for a sustainable future across various industries.





UNGC X Tatweer Misr Exchange Program

Date: July 2024

The UN Global Compact Network Egypt partnered with Tatweer Misr, a leading real estate company, for the 6th round of its Innovation Competition. Tatweer Misr's Innovation Competition aimed to revolutionize the real estate sector by inviting creative minds to develop innovative solutions addressing sustainability, livability, and wellness, aligning their solutions with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), addressing challenges like smart city planning and biodiversity preservation.

The UNGC Network Egypt, serving on the judging panel, selected winners who were rewarded with an exchange trip to Germany and the Netherlands. Organized with Denk Vision, a German NPO, the 9-day trip offered opportunities to present projects to top companies and universities while exploring sustainability best practices. This collaboration highlighted innovation's role in achieving the SDGs and reinforced cross-border partnerships for sustainable urban development.

UNGA and Leaders Summit

Date: July 2024

The UN Global Compact Network Egypt demonstrated strong engagement and participation during the UNGA Week.

Day 1: Leaders Summit

Mr. Ayman Ismail, Chairman of the Board of Directors at UN Globa Compact Network Egypt, spoke at the session "Future-Proofing Business by Improving Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) in the Workplace."

- **Key Takeaways:** DEI as a Business Initiative: Reframing DEI as a driver of happiness and success in companies.
- Leadership Accountability: Leaders must foster open environments and champion inclusion.
- ▶ Gender Parity as a Competitive Edge: Drawing on McKinsey's insights, he emphasized how gender diversity can enhance profitability by 21%.



▶ The 2024 SDG Pioneers awards were held at the Leaders Summit, where Mennatullah AbdelGawad, the Business Sustainability Manager at Hassan Allam Holding (a UNGC participant), was honored as Egypt's sole SDG Pioneer. She was celebrated for her exceptional contributions to sustainability during the ceremony.



Global Africa Business Initiative Session:

In the session "Driving Sustainable Impacts in Africa," Abir Leheta, CEO of Egytrans and Board Member of UNGC Egypt, discussed Egytrans' commitment to sustainability.

Moderated by Walaa El-Husseiny, UNGC Egypt Country Director, the conversation highlighted:

- ▶ Carbon Reduction Goals: Egytrans' aim to cut emissions significantly by 2030.
- **Capacity Building:** Emphasis on setting short-term goals and empowering teams.
- ▶ Climate Ambition Accelerator: A transformative program providing analysis, resources, and peer learning
- Holistic Strategy: Integration of economic, social, and technological dimensions with stakeholder agagement.

Collaborative Efforts: Partnerships and regulations as key enablers for success.

The Network's participation showcased its leadership in sustainability, diversity, and global collaboration.





Social Media Statistics Comparison 2023-2024
